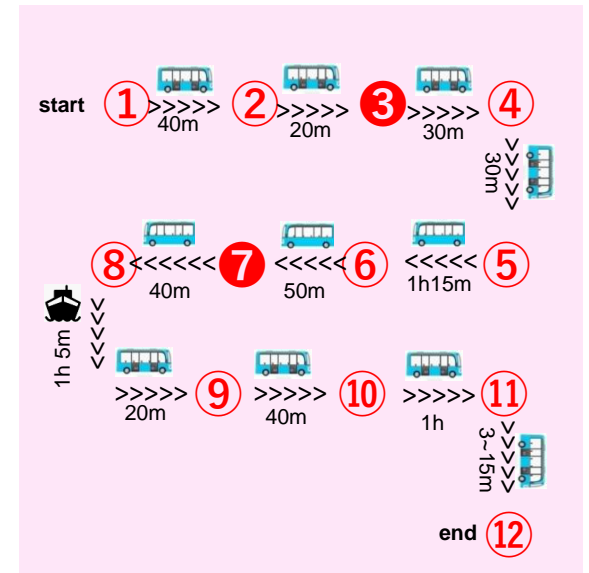
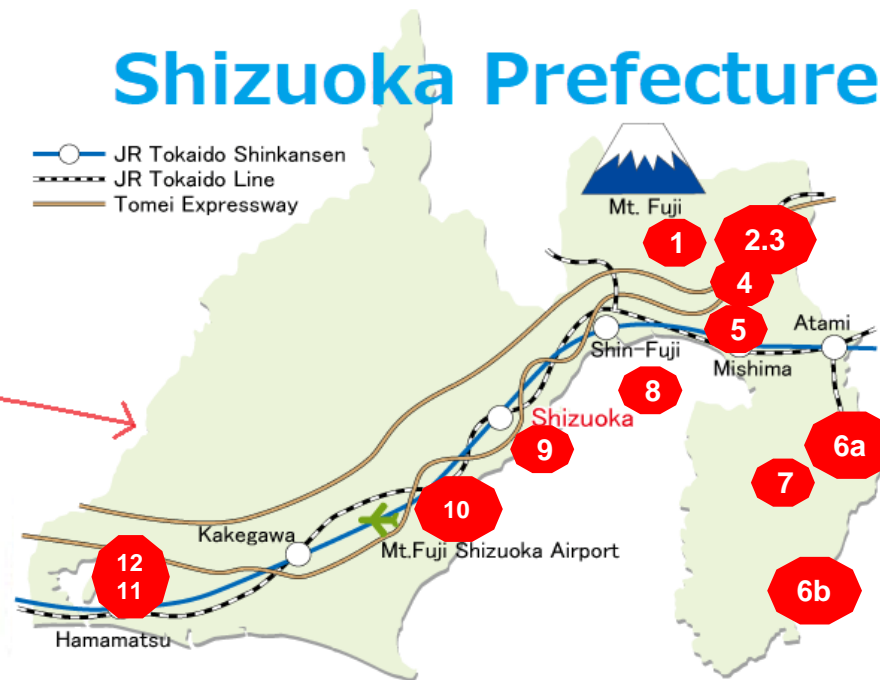

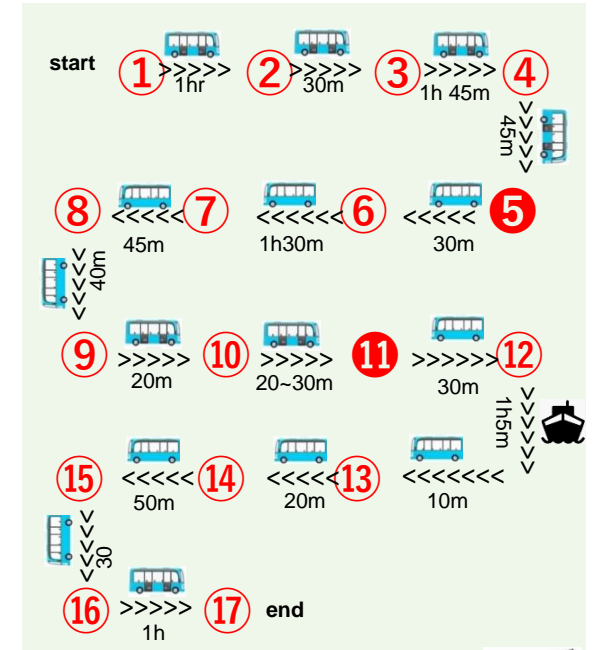

1 Ryugashido Cavern (Western Area - Hamamatsu City)

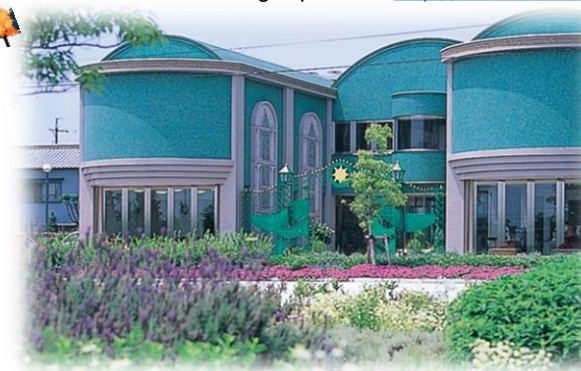

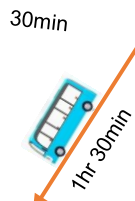

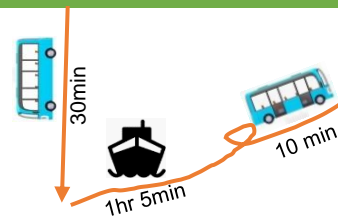
