- ① **"MISHIMA SKYWALK"** is the longest suspension bridge in Japan with a length of 400m. In the north area across the bridge, we have "Forest Adventure" where you can try "**Adventure Course**", "Long-ZIP Slide" and "Cliff Challenger". "Adventure Course" offers you various attractions including "Long-ZIP Slide" and "Tarzan Swing" where you plunge right into the net from 11m high. The highlight of the course is "Long ZIP Slide" where you slide towards Mt. Fuji and the bridge.
